IPEDS is the only freely available source of this benchmarking data. The paywall for ACRL data causes an equity issue for poorer institutions. IPEDS allows us to compare data among similar libraries and bring attention to needs with our administration and can help us to improve our services by supporting teaching. Learning, and research. ACRL is focused solely on library data, and so data is not considered within the context of the entire institution. Another result will be the fragmentation of data, as different entities will try to fill the gap. There will no longer be a consistent, reliable data collection tool (many current data collection services now align with IPEDS descriptions and categories).
