- There will be a huge impact on the State and the State Association if they are not able to see the outcomes that clients have reached by using the annual reports. If not using the annual report (606) 573-9341 there is no way of showing how many clients received an outcome and not just a service. This will be a burden to all agencies as this will require additional time and reporting.
- Changing the wording of most of the outcomes to service to language (received, enrolled)
  diminishes the achievements of the outcome. Harlan CAA has concerns that the quality and
  effectiveness of the FNOIs and Services may be diminishing. Our agency will have difficulties in
  accurately demonstrating the process we have made in assisting our clients towards economic
  security.
- 3. Harlan CAA has concerns with the new OCS Dashboard website that will roll out in the future. If Harlan CAA is lumping services and not showing outcomes, how will this look on the website to the public, legislators, and other funding sources, etc.? We are afraid, this will weaking the work that CSBG eligible entities do.
- 4. Harlan CAA proposes leaving the following in the All-Characteristics Report: Income sources allows us to know who we are serving and helps to breakdown myths of who we served.
