Discussion

Section 1. Previous IRB approval

On December 17, 2023, the IRB granted you full approval with a final disposition for your research packet and all related items pertaining to the study entitled The Real Cost Campaign: Creative Concept Testing Designed to Prevent Youth and Young Adult Cigarette Smoking (CIGS W7 Focus Groups), KDHRC IRB Protocol # 2023-07-06. Today, March 18, 2024, I reviewed your amendment request and offer the following outcomes:

Outcome 1:

I determine that the research study described in KDHRC IRB Protocol # 2023-07-06 and the amendment continues to meet the criteria found in the risk category described in 45 CFR 46.404: "Research not involving greater than minimal risk."

Outcome 2:

I accept the amendment and therefore the entirety of the revised packet for this study, rendering it applicable for exclusive use in the research study described in KDHRC IRB Protocol # 2023-07-06, but only in its fully approved form as determined by the IRB. The expiration date of this packet remains unchanged as September 25, 2024.

Outcome 3:
