Jackson,

Thank you for submitting a comment on the *Residential Utility Disconnections Survey*.

Congress tasked the U.S. Energy Information Administration with determining if collecting disconnection data from natural gas and electric utilities is feasible. We will invite utilities of various ownership types (investor-owned, municipal, cooperative, etc.) to complete the survey. We performed extensive pretesting to see which data we could reasonably collect and at what level of detail. We will publish these data at the utility level with their corresponding ownership type. However, to ease the burden of this survey on very small utilities, we will exclude the smallest utilities from the survey. In the aggregate, these companies make up a very small percentage of the natural gas and electric utility customers, and we will still meet the required coverage standards of over 95% of all customers.

Assuming the Office of Management and Budget (OMB) approves the survey, we will start collecting the disconnection data for 2024 in early 2025. We plan to publish data at the utility level with ownership codes and aggregate it to the state, census division, and national levels.
