

Coverdell 2024 OMB SPD-15 Update

Background and Justification

Coverdell Program is following 2024 OMB SPD-15 directive and making Coverdell compliant by updating race and ethnicity. The current dataset consists of 167 data elements (DE) for treatment of stroke patients. There 8 pre-hospital data elements and 159 in-hospital data elements. The current seven race and ethnicity data elements are part of in-hospital data elements. There are seven categories in the 2024 OMB SPD-15 data elements, in *Figure 2. Race and Ethnicity Question with Minimum Categories Only and Examples*. Therefore, there will be no change in the total number of data elements. This update to incorporate 2024 OMB SPD-15 align with the current purpose and scope of existing Coverdell data elements and helps enhance accuracy of data elements. The number of overall data elements will remain at 167. There is no overall change in burden. In addition to this update to DEs, CDC is also seeking a three-year approval for this data collection for this extension ICR.

We propose to update 6 race questions and 1 ethnicity question based on OMB Statistical Policy Directive 15. Capturing this will enhance the accuracy of data elements.
