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I am a woman, and I have F on my passport, and I am not threatened at all by the existence of X on any other person's passport. Americans should have the right to have their documents reflect who they really are, and it is not the government's job to police gender markers in this way. In fact, it is unconstitutional and a violation of our rights to self determination and privacy.

I urge you to keep X as an option for US passports. We should keep the trans- and non-binary inclusive government policies that we have established in this country.

Failing that, I would urge the abolition of any gender markers on our passports. It's none of the government's business, and unnecessary on a government ID to include gender markers. That would save a lot of bureaucracy, time, and money.
