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The changes proposed relating to requesting biological sex at birth for U.S. Passport applications genuinely seem confusing and unnecessary to me. If an individual chooses to present and identify themselves in a gender differing from that assigned at birth, would it not be best to identify and register that individual given their present gender identity? Forcing a definition that is not compatible with their identity and image at the time of their passport application name change, data correction, or replacement, seems counter to what a government ID is for. It would also potentially subject those individuals to discrimination.
