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Compliance with the executive order that claims to be "defending women from gender ideology" (which any sound of mind person would know is nonsense just from the title alone) is a foolish waste of resources that only serves to further unconstitutional discrimination against transgender people. A gender marker is an only-sometimes-effective aid in confirming a person's identity that frankly ought to be removed altogether, but reverting it back to "biological sex" will, in instances of using it to visually identify someone, only add confusion to the situation and make trans people easier targets for violence and abuse. Given the vast amount of other, more important information that is used to confirm a person's identity, the gender marker should be removed, but failing that, it should certainly not be made into a priority issue that requires spending time and money for the sole purpose of enacting discrimination. Letting people simply continue to choose their own gender marker is far more efficient (if it ain't broke, don't fix it, as they say) and will generally allow for their documentation to actually match their appearance.
