Several states (such as California, Colorado, Connecticut, Illinois, Maine, Massachusetts, Michigan, Nevada, New Jersey, New Mexico, New York, Oregon, Rhode Island, Utah, Vermont, and Washington) permit the modification of gender markers on key identifying documentation, including drivers' licenses and birth certificates. Moreover, many of these states also allow the use of nonbinary (e.g. X) gender markers. Thus, to ensure consistency of identifying documentation that would permit verification of the individual, passport gender markers ought to be easily changeable with the appropriate supporting documentation, and should reflect not only male and female but also nonbinary gender markers.
