I strongly oppose the proposed changes to passport forms DS-11, DS-82, and DS-5504, which would replace gender with "biological sex at birth" in compliance with the Defending Women from Gender Ideology Extremism and Restoring Biological Truth to the Federal Government executive order. This change is impractical, unnecessary, and does nothing to improve the accuracy or security of identification documents.

Passports and government IDs exist to verify identity as it applies in real-world scenarios—such as travel and security screenings—not to record an individual's medical history. Officials rely on these documents to match a person to their photo, not to validate their assigned sex at birth. I urge the Department of State to reject this change and maintain passport policies that prioritize accuracy, practicality, and the dignity of all citizens.
