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As a "biological" woman, I in no way have felt the impact, or any threat, of losing my identity as a woman by anyone else using whatever gender they feel is necessary. Violence to women by transgender people is non existent, and allowing transgender people to travel freely and exist as humans is harming literally NO ONE. Trying to require these changes to push a political agenda is a waste of time and money.

Gender is how someone identifies. A passport is *identification*. How they identify should be what is on their passport. If there is a trans man with a beard, and there is "F" on his passport, how much time would it take to confirm this? How much *wasted* time and money. It should have no bearing on proving he is a citizen, and he has a ticket. The President has no authority in this matter. Also, requiring this change is in violation of the enjoinder put on State by the U.S. District Court for the District of Colorado in the Zzyym v. Blinken case (formerly Zzyym v. Pompeo, Zzyym v. Tillerson, and Zzyym v. Kerry)

This change is unnecessary, and infringes upon fundamental human rights.
