I would like to argue that the changes proposed to the passport renewal process by Donald Trump's "Defending Women from Gender Ideology Extremism and Restoring Biological Truth to the Federal Government" Executive Order, specifically forcing that individuals who previously had a sex marker different from that on their birth certificate revert to their original designation, violate citizens' constitutional rights to privacy and bodily autonomy, and have no practical function in the areas of recordkeeping or keeping Americans safe.
