This proposed change adds unnecessary burdens on the government, especially since there is no way to verify an individual's physical sex that is not needlessly invasive.

The removal of the "x" option is also concerning because by default, this will create more confusing, inaccurate data, especially since some intersex, and also several types of gender non conforming citizens cannot be sorted into simple M and F categories in a way that complies with these rules.
