The changes being made as a result of E.O. 14168 are deeply transphobic and will prevent many citizens from attaining passports. People who have X gender markers on their travel documents are excluded from the stated changes, and the emphasis on "sex" over gender and push to declare sex assigned at birth are inherently discriminatory. This executive order and all actions taken under it inherently discriminate against trans citizens on the basis of their gender, and as such should be illegal and unconstitutional. Trans people deserve to live with dignity and travel as easily as cis people do.
