Having the government form limited to male and female sex is removing both accuracy and reality from the passport. Intersex people may not have clear features of being either male or female at birth or may have clear features of one gender at birth and another at puberty. There should be a way for them to easily change their gender if they feel that better matches up with their bodies and feelings.

Nonbinary people aren't accurately put into either the male or female field either.
