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This change leads to less accuracy and ease of identification. My sex at birth is irrelevant to the gender I identify as and present as. If you want to identify me by looking at the information on my passport you likely need to know that I will present as female and answer to female pronouns. The fact that my genitals looked female at my birth almost 50 years ago is irrelevant to identifying me now.

(Also this rule is being put into place solely to enforce a gender binary and mind other people's business. This is stupid. This rule has nothing to do with "restoring biological truth the federal government." The "truth" this rule is trying to enforce isn't scientifically true anyway. Gender and sex are not the same thing and there is more to sex than what a doctor thinks you are at birth.)
