My wife recently applied for a new passport requesting a Name and Gender change. This was filed before January 20th, 2025 and the EO. She filed all of the correct and necessary paperwork and should have received a new passport in line with the application she submitted.

After the executive order, we had to contact our Congressperson to get an in-person appointment because the Passport office was withholding all of her documents and we had absolutely no idea when she would receive the passport. She eventually received a passport with a new name, but "M" sex marker.

This is going to cause significant safety issues while traveling. She is a woman and under no circumstances would she ever be mistaken as a man. We are a lesbian couple and would likely be separated if something were to happen. Additionally, she has all of her documents updated except for this one, and there is no way to correct it or resolve it. She has still not received any of her original documents she submitted when applying for her passport, and no one has answers as to when we will get them back.

We applied under the correct paperwork and followed the due process for a sex marker change. We received an incorrect passport and none of the documents we sent in. We are also unsure what to do for TSA Precheck, as now, her ID and Passport don't match anymore.

We would like this EO invalidated. This completely strips her of her dignity and creates issues that didn't exist before.
