- --> It creates travel and legal nightmares for cis people. Incorrect gender markers are accidentally given to cis people all the time, this EO means that they're now going to be trapped with a passport that may mismatch their state ID and possibly even their SSN, and mismatched IDs can create all kinds of legal headaches. (And now it seems they're reverting gender markers to the earliest document they have of you, so even if you had it corrected in the past, it will be reverted to the erroneous version.)
