I do NOT support the government forcing people to put a sex assignment that does not match their present identity on their passport. This change would be completely illogical - it would make passports a less accurate identity document by forcing trans, non-binary and intersex people's passports to \*not\* match their identity and presentation. It would cause confusion at border control when people do not appear to have a correct passport, and would undermine states' rights, causing conflict between state IDs that allow trans and non-binary gender identities.

I don't even understand why gender/sex is necessary on IDs at all. My sex has nothing to do with my right to have a passport, travel, or do anything else I'm using a photo ID for.

This change would put unequal and undue burden on trans, non-binary and intersex US citizens, violating their equal rights as citizens.

As a cisgender US citizen and passport holder, this change would in no way make my life easier or safer. There is no benefit whatsoever, and it risks creating longer processing times for all citizens and discriminatory delays for trans, non-binary and intersex citizens.
