Passport renewal should allow for transgender individuals to have the sex that they self-identify as on their identification. Trans people's passports should be allowed to match their appearances and identities, because if, for example, a trans woman is travelling, she is percieved as a woman but if her ID says M, that can put her in danger. Trans women are at a higher risk of violence and discrimination than other groups.
