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I beg of you to reject this policy change. This change offers zero material benefit to anyone in the United States of America, yet directly places intersex and transgender citizens such as myself directly in danger when traveling abroad by unnecessarily "outing" us as intersex or transgender. The Trump administration's executive order which precedes this policy change attempts to deny the fundamental reality that intersex and transgender people exist. The implementation of the order in these proposed policy changes violates our rights guaranteed under the Constitution. The Fifth Amendment's Due Process Clause protects our right to travel abroad from arbitrary and indiscriminate government restrictions. The danger this policy places us in, as well as the invasion of our privacy and individual burden in requiring evidence of our biological sex at birth, are definitionally arbitrary and indiscriminate government restrictions. There is no fairness or reason in this policy change which denies the reality of intersex and transgender citizen's existence and right to travel abroad safely. Reject this policy change, and protect the rights of US citizens as is your responsibility.
