



Objection to proposed change to EEO form

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I am writing to protest the removal of sexual orientation and gender identity from EEO complaints. Under current law (Bostock v Clayton County, 2020 ruling) the Supreme Court ruled in a 6–3 decision that discrimination on the basis of sexual orientation or gender identity is necessarily also discrimination "because of sex" as prohibited by Title VII. Therefore, by removing the categories of sexual orientation and gender identity from the EEO complaint form, these types of discrimination will become unrecognizable.
