I am the County Veteran Service Officer for Los Angeles County and my VA accredited staff frequently assist veterans who are released from incarceration that struggle to have their benefits reinstated often taking over 30 days. This dynamic creates unnecessary financial hardship on veterans who completed their sentence and their dependents setting our veterans up for unsuccessful re-entry into society. The fix is to automate the process of re-instating VA compensation upon release from incarceration.
