As a condition of receiving a Supplemental Disaster Relief Program (SDRP) Stage 2 payment, producers were required to purchase crop insurance or coverage under the Noninsured Crop Disaster Assistance Program (NAP) with a coverage level of 60/100 or higher for the first two consecutive crop years after receiving an SDRP payment. By signing FSA-526, SDRP Stage 2 Application Form, on [insert date], you agreed to meet this requirement as a condition of receiving an SDRP Stage 2 payment.
