Broadcast Station Renewal Application

Dear Mr. Fraser:

Station Resource Group ("SRG") is an alliance of public media organizations that operate leading public radio stations across the country. The National Federation of Community Broadcasters ("NFCB") is an alliance of stations, producers and others committed to community radio. This comment asks for a revision to the above-referenced form to reduce the paperwork burden on noncommercial radio broadcasters.

The Federal Communications Commission ("FCC") has submitted for approval by Office of Management and Budget ("OMB") the draft of revised FCC Form 303-S Application for Renewal of Broadcast Station License. 75 Fed. Reg. 62816 (October 13, 2010). A question added to the form in Section II, item 7, requires the applicant to certify that "its advertising sales agreements do not discriminate on the basis of race or ethnicity and that all such agreements held by the licensee contain nondiscrimination clauses." The nondiscrimination in advertising certification was added to the renewal application pursuant to the FCC's Report and Order in *Promoting Diversification of Ownership in the Broadcasting Services*, 23 FCC Rcd 5922, 5941-42 (2008), at paragraphs 49 & 50.

The proposed responses are "yes" and "no." As worded, the question will cause confusion among noncommercial broadcasters, since neither answer is correct, at least without a clarifying exhibit. Noncommercial broadcast stations are prohibited from selling advertising by Section 399B(b)(2) of the Communications Act, 47 U.S.C. § 399B(b)(2) and by Sections 73.503 and 73.621 of the FCC's Rules, 47 C.F.R. §§ 73.503 and 73.621.

SRG and NFCB respectfully request that the form be modified to include "not applicable" as a third response to Section II, item 7, and that instructions to the form indicate that licensees of noncommercial stations should answer "N/A."
