This letter is in response to the invitation for comment regarding a three-year extension and revision of the Labor Exchange Reporting System (LERS).

Let me first emphasize that the Washington State Employment Security Department (ESD) supports the collection of data to evaluate the performance and delivery of labor exchange and employment services within the One-Stop delivery system.

ESD would like to raise one concern. It is important to Washington that we continue to have immediate access to the state's ETA 9002 and VETS 200 reports. We need to retain the ability that the current reporting system allows for states to:

- Analyze performance results for accuracy prior to submission to the U.S. Department of Labor; and
- Aggregate common measures data at a local area-level consistent with state-level reporting.
