Pursuant to the Paperwork Reduction Act, Free Press submits this letter and links to over 40,000 signatures from members of the public in support of the Federal Communications Commission's April 27, 2012 Order which adopts new online posting requirements to improve public access to the existing data contained in television broadcasters' public files.¹

Free Press is a nonprofit, nonpartisan organization dedicated to promoting responsible media policies that reflect the needs and interests of the public.² Access to broadcasters' public files is a critical component of promoting transparency and public participation in the broadcast licensing process and ensuring that broadcasters, as trustees of the public airwaves, serve their local communities of license. The FCC's effort to bring stations' existing public files into the digital age is a common-sense move that will enhance public access to these important records.
