Other than the new questionnaire items listed above, the 2013 NSCG questionnaire is the same as the 2010 NSCG questionnaire except for the following minor changes

- 1) The reference date was changed throughout the questionnaire from *October 1, 2010* to *February 1, 2013*.
- 2) The number of response options for Question E7 (new cohort)/F6 (old cohort) were changed from two options to three, as follows:

2010 version

On October 1, 2010, were you living in the United States, Puerto Rico, or another U.S. territory, or were you living in another country?

- United States, Puerto Rico, or another U.S. territory
- Another country

2013 version

On February 1, 2013, were you living in the United States, Puerto Rico, or another U.S. territory, or were you living in another country?

- United States or Puerto Rico
- Another U.S. territory
- Another country

- 3) In Question A37, the abbreviation "Dept." is spelled out as "Department."
- 4) In Question A11, "25,000+ employees" was changed to "25,000 or more employees" to coincide with "10 or fewer employees" at the other end of the response scale.
- 5) The color of the paper mail questionnaire is green in the old cohort rather than purple as it was in 2010.
