## Dear Mr. Wilusz:

Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the proposed information collection for Food Stamp Program Regulations, Part 275 - Quality Control. Specifically, we want to address the burden associated with the collection of information for the sampling plan and the arbitration process.

The proposal estimates that the total annual burden hours for the sampling plan is 1.25 hours. Delaware's estimate is that we spend approximately three hours annually to research, prepare, validate and submit the sampling.

The proposal also estimates that the total annual burden hours for the arbitration process is .83 hours. For Delaware, we would estimate that the annual burden is approximately 10 hours per arbitration due

to the time spent researching, discussing and preparing a response.
