- . An Express Statement requesting the protection offered by the CII Act; and
- A Certification Statement including the submitter's contact information and certifying that the information is not customarily in the public domain.

The Express Statement and the Certification Statement must be included with all information submitted for PCII protection. <u>How to Submit Critical Infrastructure Information (CII) For PCII Protection</u> provides more details about the submission process.

All PCII is labeled with the Protection Statement by the PCII Program Office or the PCII Program Manager Designee to help ensure the material is safeguarded and protected as PCII.
