RE: The Agency for International Development Notice of Public Information Collection Requirements Submitted to OMB for Review; New Information Collection: Freedom of Information/Privacy Act Record Request Form, AID Form 507-1; OMB Number OMB 0412-XXXX, FR Docket No. 2014-09935

These comments are offered by NARA's Office of Government Information Services (OGIS), the Freedom of Information Ombudsman, regarding AID Form 507-1, which requesters may use to request access to information from the U.S. Agency for International Development (USAID) under FOIA and the Privacy Act (PA).

OGIS commends USAID for creating a form for requesters in an effort to streamline the FOIA process.

In the instructions, OGIS suggests breaking up the second sentence by using numbers to make it more reader-friendly (suggested changes in bold): "You may use any written format for a Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) or Privacy Act Request as long as it contains: 1) a description of the information you are requesting; and 2) sufficient personally identifying data when required.

OGIS also suggests deleting the sentence "Failure to provide the required information may result in no action being taken on the request" with a more reader-friendly "Without this required information, USAID cannot process your request."

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
