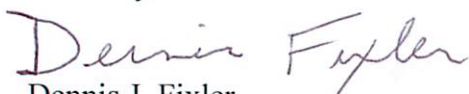

The importance of the information gathered through the TPOPS cannot be overstated. Information from this survey is used as the sampling universe for selecting establishments at which prices of specific items are collected and monitored for use in the BLS' Consumer Price Index (CPI) Program. BEA uses CPIs primarily to deflate numerous components of PCE, the change in private inventories, and state and local government purchases.
