Regarding: CMS-10500Outpatient/Ambulatory Surgery Patient Experience of Care Survey (O/ASPECS)

I would like to submit for review discussion on the following questions on the proposed patient survey:

- #10 Please consider removing the statement "Anesthesia is something that would make you feel sleepy or go to sleep during your procedure." and leaving, "Were you given anesthesia?" I think even the average lay person understands what anesthesia is and this seems overly simplistic and potentially demeaning.
- #16 Please consider changing the verbiage to "At any time after leaving the facility, did you have pain that was unmanageable as a result of your procedure?" It is my opinion that if you simply ask them if they had pain every answer would be yes. They just had surgery. I think we have to determine if their pain was manageable when they left.
- #18 Please consider changing this question as "At any time after leaving the facility" would then encompass the potential side effects included in the use of Pain Medication. Perhaps including "as a result of anesthesia, your procedure, or subsequent use of pain medication?" I think it would be important to define whether the PONV was a result of anesthesia or use of pain medication.

#20 - Please consider amending to include "in which you sought further consultation." To the layperson "normal" bleeding is still bleeding and does not indicate a concern post op. It would be nice to quantify that they had to seek further consult as a result.

#24 - I would like to see the order reversed to have the positive statements first.
