> > cultural  
> > world. The award is sponsored by the Federal Geographic  
> Data  
> > Committee  
> > (FGDC) and its purpose is to recognize an individual or  
> a  
> > team  
> > representing Federal, State, Tribal, regional, and  
> (or)  
> > local  
> > government, academia, or non-profit and professional  
> > organization that  
> > has developed an outstanding, innovative, and  
> operational  
> > tool,  
> > application, or service capability used by multiple  
> > organizations that  
> > furthers the vision of the National Spatial Data  
> > Infrastructure (NSDI).  
> > National nominations are accepted from the  
> > public and private  
> > sector individuals, teams, organizations, and
