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General Comment

I believe the GSA has significantly underestimated such burdens and foresee the proposed monthly transactional reporting requirements morphing into a significant monthly burden for GSA Schedule Contractors - especially true for small business contractors. In addition, such reporting would, no doubt, add yet another pre-award and post award contract audit element.

GSA's goal to provide its Govt. customers the best value products and services is more likely achieved by reducing cost and reporting burdens the agency places on its sch. contractors. Further, this proposed rule appears counter to the Paperwork Reduction Act to have Federal agencies become more responsible and publicly accountable for reducing the burden of Federal paperwork on the public, and for other purposes.
