Arizona Industries for the Blind is a qualified nonprofit agency for the blind participating in the AbilityOne program authorized by the Javits-Wagner-O'Day Act. We are responding to the March 21, 2008 notice in the <u>Federal Register</u> published by the Committee for purchase.

- 1. We believe that individual project recordkeeping will be a non-value added cost that our customers will not be willing to pay for. We estimate that it would take an additional resource, software upgrade and new hardware to implement.
- Recordkeeping by product or service family should be sufficient. We request OMB to approve recordkeeping only by product or service family.
