

Dear Iowa Department of Inspections and Appeals:

Thank you for submitting comments to Federal Register listing FNS-2015-0018-0001, Agency Information Collection Activities; Proposals, Submissions, and Approvals: Food Program and Reporting System. This is a response from the Food and Nutrition Service (FNS) to your comments regarding burden hours and cost. All other relevant comments are addressed in the Supporting Statement for this Information Collection Request. The Supporting Statement will be publicly available upon approval by the Office of Management and Budget.

**Comment:** “Reporting accurately the data requested in these two subsections is difficult when two or more state agencies are involved without the agencies having a shared database. The DIA, Investigations Division performs fraud investigations and the DHS determines eligibility and establishes eligibility claims. The data requested in these two subsections will require information to be collected manually and will put a considerable burden on both state agencies.”

**FNS Response:** FNS removed these elements from the proposed revision. The FNS-366B will not collect information on Inadvertent Household Errors.
