Proposed Collection, Comment Request concerning the Occupational Requirements Survey (ORS)

Department of Health and Human Services Centers for Disease Control and Prevention National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health Cincinnati, Ohio The National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health (NIOSH) has reviewed the Department of Labor/Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS) *Proposed Collection, Comment Request* concerning the Occupational Requirements Survey (ORS) published in the *Federal Register* (FR) on February 18, 2015 [80 FR 8696].

The Social Security Administration (SSA) and NIOSH met on March 30, 2015 to discuss the ORS. The SSA requested NIOSH input on three areas: physical demands, mental and cognitive demands, and environmental conditions. NIOSH established point of contacts for each area and will provide additional feedback to the SSA and BLS.
