The Bureau of Economic Analysis (BEA) strongly supports the continued collection of data by the U.S. Census Bureau for the Advance Monthly Retail Trade Survey. This important survey is our main data source for key components of BEA's economic statistics.

Data on retail sales (item 4) are used to prepare monthly estimates of the personal consumption expenditures (PCE) component of gross domestic product for all PCE goods categories, except tobacco, prescription drugs, motor vehicles, and gasoline and oil. These estimates are also published each month in the *Personal Income and Outlays* press release.
