## Public Comment References

REDCOM Laboratories, Inc. submits these public comments with respect to:

## Comments

1. Inclusion of multiple forms in one super-form where same "block numbers" are reused is confusing. For example, "Block 1" appears on pages 1, 3, 6, 11.

Suggestion: Create separate forms for each of the 4 functions, or else sequentially number all block numbers without repeating block numbers in the same form.

2. Pages 1-2 does not contain a "Block 4" to allow for uploading supporting documentation or "letter of explanation."

Suggestion: Add a "Block 4" to allow for uploading of supporting information.

3. Textual fields do not allow text wrapping, making proofing of some responses impossible. For example, page 2, "Describe changes from previous agreement."

Suggestion: Allow entire textual box to be viewed.
