Thank you for your July 6, 2017, correspondence to the May 18, 2017, *Federal Register Notice* requesting comments on the U. S. Department of Education's (Department) Guide for Submitting the Consolidated Annual Report (CAR Guide) for the Carl D. Perkins Career and Technical Education Act of 2006 (Perkins IV). I am pleased to inform you that we have accepted your comments and revised the CAR Guide as described below.

The "Individual with Disabilities" definition has been modified to include "(as described in paragraph ((3)))" from the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (42 U.S.C. 12102) as amended.

The "Disabilities Status" definition has been changed to reflect the amended 20 U.S. Code Chapter 33 – Education of Individuals with Disabilities Act, Section 1401 (3) on the Department's Website at: <https://sites.ed.gov/idea/statute-chapter-33/subchapter-1/1401/3>.
