Hi Danielle,

In regards to the new Section 5 of the form, what we are looking for are the natural gas liquids (NGLs defined as ethane, propane, butane, natural gasoline) produced by the stabilizer or by the process of stabilizing your oil. These NGLs would be sent to a fractionator which separates the NGLs into its components. If the stabilizer that you use does not produce NGLs then you would enter zero in the NGL column on the form. You would enter a volume of the oil sent to the stabilizer and the volume of stabilized oil produced by the stabilizer. Please let me know if you have any further questions or feedback.
