- New Construction is the original construction work done on a project including all finishing work on the original building or structure. Land development work
 on the site and demolition of existing structures are included in new construction.
- Additions, Alterations, or Reconstruction is construction work which adds to the value of useful life of an existing building or structure, or which adapts a building or structure to a new or different use. Included are "major replacements" of building systems such as the installation of a new roof or heating system, and the resurfacing of streets or highways. Exclude activities such as the repair of a hole in a roof or the routine patching of highways and streets, which are classified as "maintenance and repair work".
- Maintenance and Repair Work is incidental construction work that keeps a property in ordinary working condition. Exclude trash and snow removal, lawn
 maintenance, and janitorial services, which are considered Services sector activities.
