<b>Comment:</b>	1800, 1802, and 1804 - Removing the value "4 = Graduate/Post Graduate" and then re-numbering the following values will cause a problem for systems that are setup to store the numerical (alias) value in their database. Making this change requires that everyone (who has already tracked a value 4, 5, 6, 7 or 8) goes back into their data and maps the old values to the new values. This is generally a consideration that is made for all text/alias value fields. Storing values as an alias makes it so you don't have to go back and update all of your data when a change to the text is made. It also requires that you do not ever change the alias value to a completely new value. It would make things easier and cause less confusion if numbers 5-8 were not changed to 4-7. *©
