The Bureau of Economic Analysis (BEA) strongly supports the continued collection of information by the Rural Utilities Service (RUS) used to derive the Electric Loan Application and Related Reporting Burdens. These surveys are our main data sources of key components for BEA's economic statistics.

Data collected on the RUS forms are critical to BEA's national income and product accounts, annual input-output accounts, gross domestic product by industry accounts, and State and local area personal income estimates. Specifically, these data are used to prepare estimates of compensation of employees, business income, net interest, depreciation, capital stock, and gross output. Items used by BEA are listed in the attachment below.
