The Bureau of Economic Analysis (BEA) strongly supports the continued collection of data by the U.S. Census Bureau for the Survey of Housing Starts, Sales, and Completions, known as the Survey of Construction (SOC). The data collected through this survey are crucial to key components of BEA's economic statistics.

BEA relies on data collected on forms SOC-QI/SF.1, Survey of Housing Starts, Sales, and Completions (Single-family Buildings) and SOC-QI/MF.1, Survey of Housing Starts and Completions (Multiunit Buildings) to prepare the national income and product accounts. BEA's use of these data is primarily indirect, in that the information on housing starts, sales price, lot value, and building characteristics from this survey is used in the Census Bureau's Survey of Construction to prepare estimates of the value of residential construction put in place series.

This series is used by BEA to prepare estimates of the residential fixed investment component of gross domestic product (GDP) and of the output of the construction industry for the annual input-output and GDP by industry accounts. Sales, sales price, lot value, and building characteristics data from these forms also are used by the Census Bureau to prepare price indexes for single family structures and price indexes for multi-family structures that are used by BEA to prepare estimates of the real residential fixed investment component of GDP and real output of the construction industry. A list of data used indirectly and directly by BEA is provided in the attachment.

Please keep BEA informed about any modifications to this survey. We are particularly interested in any modifications proposed during the survey's approval process that would substantially affect our use of these data.
