Just a few suggested changes to Form I-526, as follows:

Part 1

7.a.-7i. (and other address fields throughout): Permit commas, periods and hyphens

28.h.: Permit D/S

Part 2

4.: Consider modifying the item from the approved Regional Center application to the approved or pending Regional Center application

Part 5

3.: Change current salary to current/proposed salary

4.: Change to What are the costs for benefits you receive/will receive in your position/proposed position in the NCE?

11.: Change Capital Derived From to Capital Derived/to be Derived From

Part 8

Petitioners or Authorized Signatorys Declaration and Certification

Given the majority of I-526 petitions are based on commercial enterprises affiliated with a regional center, and the regional center or NCE typically provides the Petitioner with a set of documents relating to the business, in most cases the Petitioner will not have seen the original documents, making it difficult to attest to the copies being exact

photocopies. Consider amending the attestation to reflect that the photocopies were provided to Petitioner by the regional center or NCE to Petitioner, and represented to Petitioner as being exact photocopies of unaltered, original documents.
