Persistent homelessness problem is raising tensions amongst the public. 7,499 homeless people in San Francisco a recorded last year, with the amount of feces scattered on the streets is among the worst ever seen, and San Francisco report , 2016 found that people in tents along Division Street between South Van Ness Avenue and 11th Street are living among garbage, human feces, hypodermic needles, urine and other insanitary conditions, the department said. mattresses, broken bicycles, overflowing shopping carts and piles of garbage, some of it illegally dumped. Motorists waiting at the signal light peer out from behind rolled-up windows at a scene some have compared to a refugee camp. living in filthy conditions with no sanitation, complaints about garbage, sewage, violence, aggressive panhandling and other concerns. A homeless encampment has been at the same location off and on since at least October 2014. Los Angeles, More than 17 percent of small children tested here have shown elevated levels of lead in their blood, according to previously undisclosed L.A. County health data. Children who test at or above 5 micrograms per deciliter of blood threshold warrant a public health response. Clean Air AND water that Congress enacted recognizes that air and water pollution preventionand air pollution control at its source, ( IN BIG CITIES) are the primary source for the large population, so Stop the Big City pollution. \*🌐
