Re: Comment Request: H2A Recordkeeping Requirement

As an association of livestock producers, MPAS appreciates the Department of Labor's continuing efforts to reduce paperwork and respondent burden.

The Information Collection Request (ICR) pertaining to program obligations for employer's seeking to hire foreign temporary workers for jobs in herding and production of livestock on the open range, in its current form is appropriate and sufficient for the proper performance of the functions of the agency.

The agency's estimate of the burden due to this ICR is applicable and the required method of collection is suitable for maintaining quality, utility and clarity of information.

In its current form, this ICR, is practical for employers. In part the practicality is due to the economical and time efficient method of recording this information. As such, the collection of information in its current form, is not overly burdensome to employers and still accomplishes utility in the DOL performing its function.
