Thank you for your response to the Federal Register Notice for the Child Nutrition Program Operations Study II (CN-OPS II).

The USDA Food and Nutrition Service is committed to using timely, useful data on policy, technical, and operational issues within the Child Nutrition (CN) programs. The purpose of this revision is to update the survey instruments for school year (SY) 2018-19 to include topics of current interest and collect data that will help FNS better understand and address current policy issues related to CN program operations. This information will also help FNS improve training and technical assistance to States and local agencies.

FNS is mindful of the burden it places on respondents asked to participate in this study. To minimize burden and facilitate ease of use, the surveys will be conducted electronically. As noted in our previous response to SNA comments in December 2016, the electronic survey format allows respondents to save their work and return to the survey at a later date.
